 - *From measure 295 to first beat of measure 333.
- * <<Concerto>> and <<Orchestral Excerpt>> must be filmed uncut.
- * Please upload the video you shoot without editing to YouTube as an unlisted video and include the URL in your resume and application form.
- * After the video screening, all applicants will be notified of the result by email.

■ Video Recording Guideline

- YouTube video must be taken horizontally.
- YouTube video must be unedited, taken from the same camera angle throughout and must clearly show the Applicant's fingerings, full face and instrument.
- All pieces from the repertoire list must be recorded in one track.
- YouTube video may be excluded from judgment if it was perceived that the hand movement of the Applicant during his or her performance does not synchronize with the sound.
- An automatic audio volume control function of video camera (AGC, ALC, etc.) shall not be used.
 This is because it reduces dynamics and nuances and often results in a recording which does not accurately represent the performance.



- YouTube video shall not have extremely loud (or quiet) sound volume, and shall not contain noise.
- Post "Name" and "Violin" in the title of the video you upload.
- Post the start time of the performance and the title of the assigned piece as chapters in the video description.
